## **Westmuir SWRI**



Westmuir belongs to the S.W.R.I. which is the Scottish Women's Rural Institute. The aims of the organisation are

- 1) to advance the education and training of those who are interested in country life, home-skills, family welfare and citizenship
- 2) to promote the preservation of Scotland's traditions and rural heritage.

The organisation is open to all women regardless of age, colour or faith.

Westmuir is part of **Angus Federation**. There are forty institutes in Angus & thirty four Federations throughout Scotland.





Westmuir SWRI was founded in 1923. At present there are 27 members and we meet on **the first Thursday of each month**, **apart from July & August**. The organising committee consists of 10 members who are responsible for producing a **syllabus** for the year and ensuring the meetings run efficiently. There is usually a speaker and we cover diverse subjects such **as flower arranging, cookery demonstrations, issues of local interest & travel**. Each month there are 2 **competitions** to **encourage** and **develop the skills of the housewife**. At the end of the season, trophies are presented to the winners. A highlight of the year is the **Federation Show** held in Forfar in March when all Angus Institutes compete in as many of the 58 classes of Housewives & Handcrafts as they wish.

However, if housewifely skills are not your forte, there are **Sporting Competitions** as well. **Green Bowling, Stadium Bowling, Golf** and **Curling** are all competed within Angus Federation & the winners go on to take part at **National level**.
